



## Medication Form - 2017

### If Your Child Requires Medication at Camp...

For the safety of all Valley Trails campers, all medication must be hand delivered by the PARENT/GUARDIAN, to the main office or to the staff supervisor on board a camp bus. Campers are not to be held responsible to deliver medication to the office, nor may they carry any medication or over-the-counter drugs at camp. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

If your camper requires the use of an inhaler or Epi-pen, we require that Valley Trails Summer Camp be supplied with TWO individually labeled inhalers/Epi-pens. One inhaler/Epi-pen will remain in the camp office and the other will be carried by your camper's Senior Counselor. Both inhalers/Epi-pens will be returned to the parent at the conclusion of your camper's experience at Valley Trails Summer Camp.

No medicine may be dispensed without the written authorization of your child's physician.
